Homework: Hanna's Cold Winter: Brainstorming

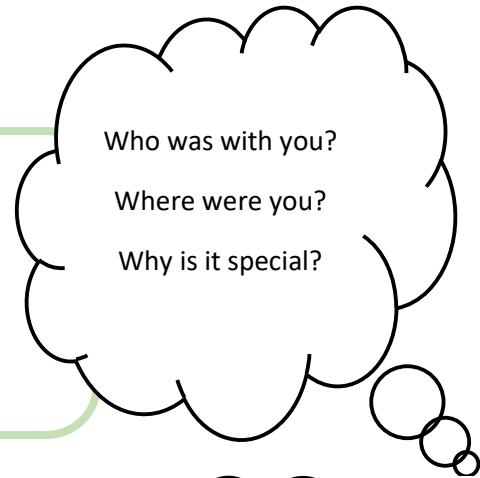
In *Hanna's Cold Winter*, Tibor tells a story about a special memory when he was little. Think back over some of your childhood experiences.

- Can you remember a time when you (or someone in your family) came up with a helpful solution to a problem (like Tibor's dad did)?

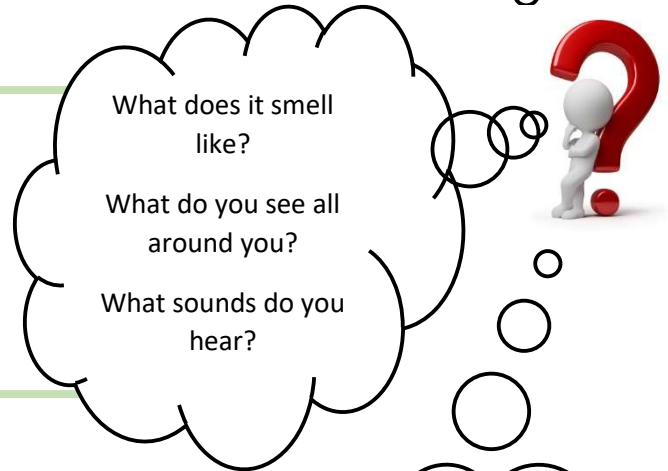

Then list your ideas below. This is called "Brainstorming".

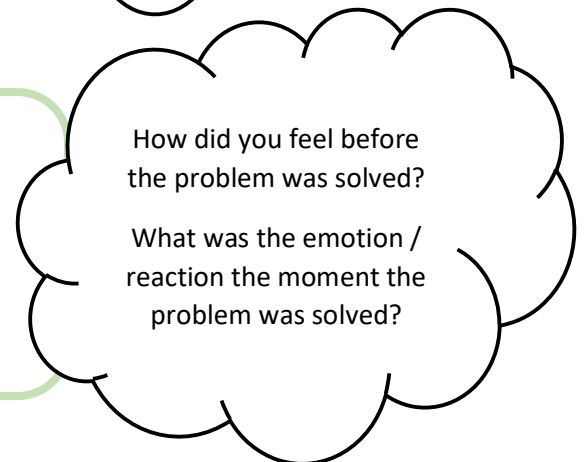
