
Lessons from the Lord in Literature...

Your book report should include:


- What the book was about (including the main characters and the setting)

- Tell us about a character(s) you really liked

You could make a dish from the book to share. You could create something from the book. Be prepared to stand in front of the class and speak about your book and your creations for several minutes.
