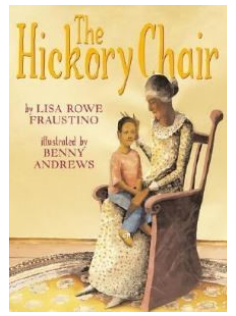

Reflections

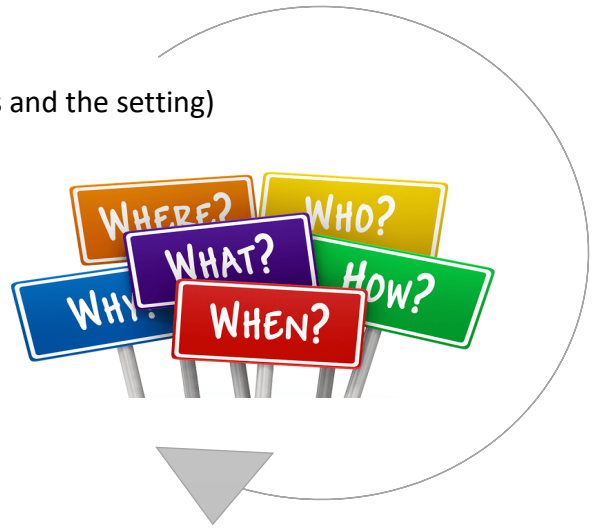
Think back over the school year and the books you have read. Did you have a favorite book?

Your book report should include:



- What the book was about (including the main characters and the setting)
- Why did you like the book?
- What was your favorite part?
- Some type of picture, collage, or diorama from a favorite scene in the book



It could (but doesn't have to) include:

- Would you have chosen a different ending?
- What made this book memorable to you?
- Did it remind you of something in your own life?
- Tell us about a character(s) you really liked

This is your big presentation! Impress me. Create a folder. Draw a cover. Write out your report with neat handwriting. Draw a picture of your favorite scene from the book. And then add some extras of your choice. Choose one extra creative thing to do or make. You could create a diorama. You could write a poem about your favorite character. You could make a dish from the book to share. You could create something from the book. Be prepared to stand in front of the class and speak about your book and your creations for several minutes.
