- Why did you like the book?
- Did you have a favorite part?


It could (but doesn't have to) include:


- Would you have chosen a different ending?

And then add some extras of your choice. Choose one extra creative thing to do or make. You could create a diorama. You could write a poem about your favorite character. You could make a dish from the book to share. You could learn a new skill that a character does or create something from the book. Be prepared to stand and share your book with the class.

Your book report should be roughly 3-4 pages, as shown below:




